Helmets Compulsory on Croagh Patrick

As an additional measure for your health and safety, the wearing of a helmet on the Croagh Patrick stage of this year's event is **COMPULSORY**. Failure to wear a helmet will result in automatic disqualification from the event.

Antenna Based Timing on Croagh Patrick

Spirit Competitors – Please take note of Antenna-based timing solution on Croagh Patrick. As you arrive at the shoulder, you will see a cairn over to your left. Keep to the left of the cairn to pass the antenna, before continuing around the cairn to start your descent.

Bike Collection

Bike Collection on Saturday is **STRICTLY** from 2.30pm onwards. Due to the volume of competitors who arrived at Transition Area 1 before 2.30pm last year, there will be a member of An Garda Síochána in place. Please respect your fellow Competitors & wait until 2.30pm to collect your bike.

When returning from bike collection, you will be directed back into Westport or towards your onward journey via the grounds of Westport House. Please follow the direction of the Gardai and event marshals.

Croagh Patrick Water Refill Station

The water station at Croagh Patrick will have large bottles of water available for competitors to refill their own water bottles. There will be no cups or small water bottles available in line with our sustainable policy.

Parking On Race Day

Limited parking is available for competitors at the Sacred Heart School car park from

7am on Saturday 8th November. This car park is located across the road from the Westport Plaza & Castlecourt Hotel Resort. Gates will be open from 7am.
